

Jane Miller announces she will seek re-election (Jan-28-2009)

Oak Ridge Mayor Pro Tem Jane Miller has announced that she will be a candidate for re-election for Oak Ridge City Council in the June 2 election. Miller was appointed to City Council in October 2003. Miller was successful in her run for office in a special election in August 2004 winning 46 percent of the vote against five opponents, and was again successful in her re-election bid in June 2005. Miller was elected Mayor Pro Tem in July 2007.

“It is s a challenging time to serve on Oak Ridge City Council, but I love working with citizens and businesses to address their issues to make our community a better place to live and work. I look forward to an exciting and aggressive campaign.”

Miller has been an advocate for improving communication with citizens, improved housing, retail development, neighborhood cleanup and codes enforcement, and led the “Council's Night Out” initiative so that citizens can informally meet one-on-one with Council members and city staff to discuss important issues. Miller works closely with citizens in various parts of the city, both one-on-one and with neighborhood groups, toward addressing and solving specific issues and concerns.

Miller is a graduate of Oak Ridge High School and the University of Tennessee, where she earned a B.S. in Business Management. In addition to her time on Oak Ridge City Council, Jane has worked with B&W Y-12 since November 2000 as a Public Relations Staff Specialist.

Miller served as Chairman of the Oak Ridge Convention and Visitors Bureau Board of Directors before her appointment to Council and continues to be an advocate for tourism. Miller represents Council on the Anderson Council Tourism Council and serves on the Council Rules Committee and the Intergovernmental Relations Committee. She has served Chair of the Secret City Festival fundraising for the past several years.

Miller is a graduate of Leadership Oak Ridge and East Tennessee Regional Leadership. She is a member of the noon Oak Ridge Rotary Club and continues to be active with the Oak Ridge Chamber of Commerce. Miller was a finalist in the 2008 Knoxville YWCA tribute to women in the government/business category. She and her husband, Barry Vickers, teach Kindergarten Sunday School and work with the AWANA Club at Central Baptist Church.
